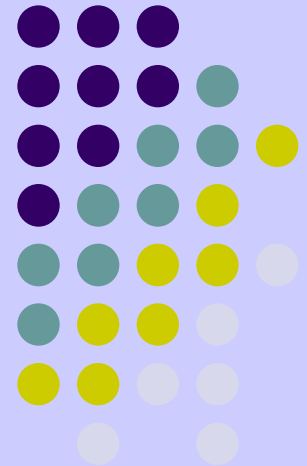


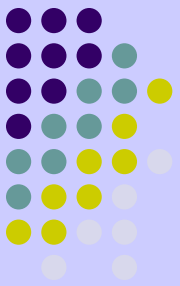

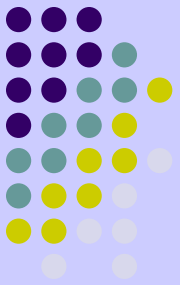


Joint Criminal Enterprise (JCE)



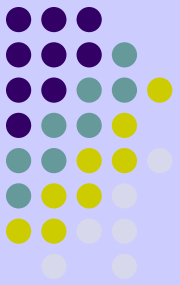

| <ul style="list-style-type: none">participated in a JCE, and that the purpose of this JCE was the permanent forcible removal, through the commission of crimes, of a majority of the Croat, Muslim and other non-Serb populations from specific areas (including Krajina region) | <ul style="list-style-type: none">participated in a JCE, the common purpose of which was the permanent removal of the Serb population from the Krajina region in Croatia by force. |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">the JCE came into existence before 1 August 1991 and Šešelj was a part of it until September 1993. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">Operation Storm ("Oluja") - launched on 4 August 1995 and last 3 days |

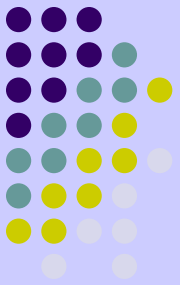

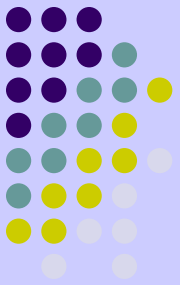
